

Church Music Week

We find this very familiar verse in the latter stanzas of Psalms 113-118. These passages are often called the “Egyptian Hallel.” They are verses of praise to God that are sung during the Jewish celebration of the Passover to commemorate the Israelite’s escape from Egyptian bondage.

This is the hymn Jesus, and His disciples sang at the end of the first Lord’s supper meal. It’s incredible to think about the 24 hours between that meal and the next sundown. Jesus would be betrayed by Judas, arrested by a mob, interrogated by the Sanhedrin, denied by Peter, handed over to Pilate, mocked by Herod Antipas, brought back to Pilate, have His freedom revoked and given to a convicted murderer, be beaten by the military, and ultimately led to His crucifixion between two criminals.

Jesus, of course, knew all of this was about to happen when He sang the hymn with His disciples—but He still sang, “this is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad in it.”

As we gather for Worship, let us be reminded again of the faithfulness of Christ as we sing. Regardless of the circumstances of our lives, we can sing with the hope and surety of our salvation, bought with the blood of Christ. This is the day that the Lord has made, and we will rejoice and be glad!

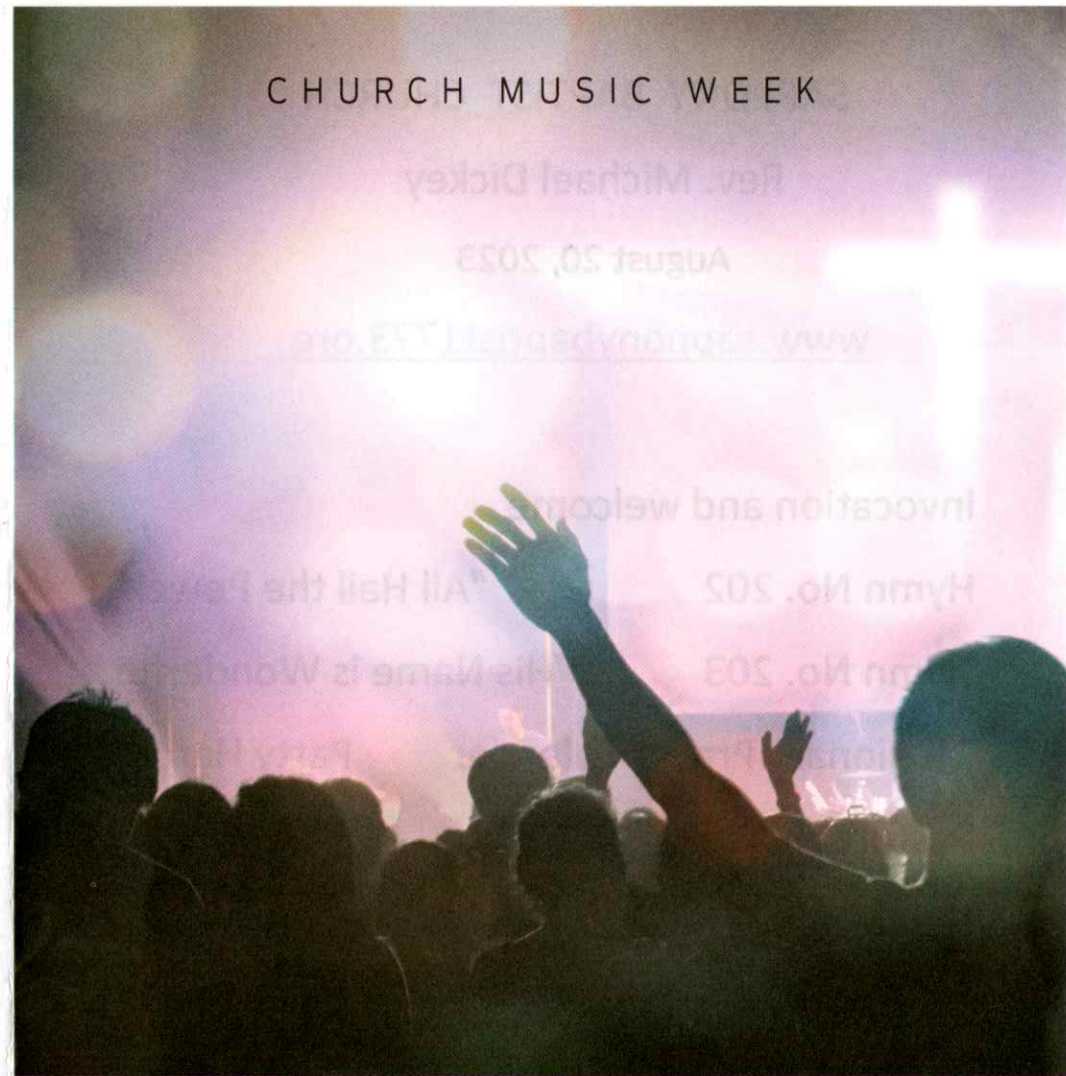
